

Involving Single Dog Entries

GPGRC & CVGRC Veterans Classes*: Classes for dogs & bitches 7 years & under 10 years, 10 years and under 12 years and 12 years and over. Sexes divided.

Hunting Retriever Classes*: Classes for dogs & bitches that have earned an AKC Junior, Senior or Master Hunter title under AKC rules. Sexes divided.

Field Trial Classes*: Classes for dogs & bitches that have won, placed or received a judge's award of merit in any AKC licensed or member field trial. Sexes divided.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows: Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible to compete in single-entry, non-regular classes. Winners of these classes will advance to compete in Best of Breed provided they have not been defeated in any other single entry class.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Junior Showmanship offered 5 times!

Thursday AM, Friday AM, Saturday AM & PM & Sunday

Novice Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. A Best Junior win with competition counts as one win toward moving to Open.

Open Class

For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class

This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

Best Junior Handler & Reserve Best Junior Handler

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at (919) 233-9767. Be sure all information for Junior classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Bitches in season are not eligible. At Specialty shows, dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

Puppy, Veteran & Gun Dog Sweepstakes

Sweepstakes offered Sunday only

(Puppy Sweepstakes entry must also be entered in the regular class at the Sunday show.)

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes are open to Golden Retrievers 6 months and under 18 months. Each entry must also be entered in the Regular Class at the CVGRC Sunday show. Champions of Record are NOT eligible to compete. Indicate Sweepstakes on the regular entry form in the space for additional classes (state age).

PUPPY CLASSES (for Dogs and Bitches)

Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months :: Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months Junior, 12 months and under 15 months :: Junior, 15 months and under 18 months

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes are open to dogs and bitches 7 years and older. Veterans Sweeps entries need NOT be entered in the Regular Classes at this show. Champions of record are eligible as are spayed and neutered Goldens. Indicate Sweepstakes on the regular entry form in the space for additional classes (state age).

VETERAN CLASSES (for Dogs and Bitches)

7 years old and under 10 years; 10 years old and under 12 years, 12 years and older

Handler Eligibility Puppy/Veteran Sweepstakes:

The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be either the owner, co-owner, breeder or member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made. Immediate family is defined as husband, wife, mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter or legal domestic partner. Stepchildren and legal wards are also included in this definition. In-laws and grandchildren are not considered to be immediate family members. No other individual may take the entry into the ring duding or check-in. It is required that the same person who showed the dog to a first place in Sweepstakes class will also show the dog in Best in Sweeps. If that person should have more than one dog in the Best in Sweepstakes class, someone else is permitted to show the additional winner. That person should met the handler definitions above.

The following individuals are excluded from showing an exhibit in sweepstakes unless they are the sole owner registered with the AKC or co-own the entry with a member of their immediate family (as defined above) or a legal domestic partner: Any individual listed as an agent on any dog in any regular or non-regular class at this range or any other show in the previous two years. Any individual with an Agent number including, but not limited to an AKC Registered Handler Number or Professional Handlers Association (PHA) number. To avoid confusion or question, it is recommended that a photocopy of the registration certificate be included with the entry for a co-owned exhibit.

GUN DOG SWEEPSTAKES

Any purebred Golden Retriever with an AKC Hunting title, ** (Derby placement or JAM or 3rd or 4th placement or JAM in Qualifying) or *** (Qualified All-Age dog) designation earned in an AKC Field Trial. Entrants need not be entered in any other class or at the regular entry fee. AKC Champions of Record and spayed and/or neutered dogs are eligible for this competition.

GUN DOG CLASSES (for Dogs and Bitches)

Junior Hunter – For dogs that have earned the AKC Junior Hunter Title Senior Hunter – For dogs that have earned the AKC Senior Hunter Title Master Hunter – For dogs that have earned the AKC Master Hunter Title

** - For dogs that have earned ** from AKC Retriever Field Trials

*** - For dogs that have earned *** from AKC Retriever Field Trials

Handler Eligibility: Anyone can show any dog in Gun Dog Sweepstakes.

Gun Dog Sweepstakes Title Eligibility: Title must be won prior to the closing date for the event.

Disabled or physically challenged handlers are encouraged to show their own dogs and every effort will be made to accommodate them.

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy offered once each day on Thursday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday

One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered for Golden Retrievers that are at least four months and under six months of age on the day of the competition. All of the puppies are exhibited in the same class and the only placements are Best of Breed (BOB) and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed (BOS).

Entry and eligibility requirements:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in this competition, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. (*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.) Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.*

(Option 2* - All Breed/All-American Rally)

4 trials total offered: 2 on Thursday, 2 on Friday

Offered Rally Classes:

Novice A & B, Intermediate, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B, Master, Choice

*Option 2: We will accept entries for Golden Retrievers first, then accept entries from all other breeds until the entry limit specified is reached (in the order they are received). Exhibitors entering a breed other than a Golden Retriever will be notified as soon as possible after the closing date regarding the status of their entry. Entries are open to All-American/Mixed Breed dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program.

RAE & RACH entries:

Please check the box on the entry form for RAE or RACH (rally).

Dogs entered in this class will be entered in both Excellent B and Advanced B (rally RAE) or Excellent B, Advanced B and Master (rally RACH). Once the limit has been reached in either class, any subsequent RAE or RACH entries will be returned in their entirety.

Rally Bitch in Season Refunds: The Club will refund 50% of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. All refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. Text emails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered. All requests must be received by the Show Secretary by 12:00 p.m. on the day of the show. Refunds are for bitches in season *only.*

Rally transfers will be permitted in accordance with Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. The request to transfer must be presented in writing to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

All Rally classes will be run in jump-height order from Small-Tall. Please include your jump height on the entry form. All rally entries must indicate class "A" or "B" and/or jump height where required.

Rally Ring size is 40' x 50'. Ring is located in Pavilion/Under cover/Jump areas will be matted

If a dog is entered in both Conformation and Rally, you must pay the fee for the first entry of the dog in EACH trial, as they are separate events.

It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.

Please keep the area cleaned up with the equipment provided. If we are to have access to these facilities again, exhibitors and handlers MUST keep them clean. There will be no smoking inside the pavilion. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.

A dog determined to be ineligible, by its owner/agent, for the class in which it has been entered may be transferred to an eligible open class at a show prior to the judging of any regular conformation class within the sex of that breed or variety, and that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

Detecting cancer and other serious health problems in Goldens with Rametrix® Molecular Urinalysis (RMU)

Rametrix Technologies, Inc., a medical/veterinary research and development company (www.rametrixtech.com), has developed a urine-based technology (RMU) to detect cancer in dogs (and people). Ramen spectroscopy profiles the molecular composition of urine, and we have published a paper showing detection in dogs of lymphoma, mast cell sarcoma, urothelial/transitional cell carcinoma, and osteosarcoma with at least 90% accuracy using RMU technology. (This paper is available on our website.)

This technology uses a small amount of free-catch/voided urine, takes less than 30 minutes, and is economical (about the same price as a standard urinalysis at the veterinarian's office). Studies we conducted in humans has also detected other diseases such as diabetic nephritis, lupus nephritis, chronic kidney failure, and bladder cancer. We will use this **translational information** gained from humans in the proposed work on Golden Retriever health.

To further validate RMU and to precisely focus it for Goldens, we want to conduct a **500-dog study** (250 healthy dogs, 250 dogs with cancer or other health problems, including kidney disease) with cooperation of the Golden Retriever Club of America. Study goals:

- Develop a Golden Retriever-specific molecular fingerprint of urine in clinically healthy Goldens
- Determine how the urine molecular fingerprint of clinically healthy dogs compares with the urine molecular fingerprint of dogs with cancer or other health problems;
- Track changes between health and disease using multiple samples from the same dog
- Detect and profile (with RMU) other common health problems in Goldens, including renal disease, heart disease, allergies, and hypothyroidism.

Ultimately, early detection of disease may alleviate suffering and save lives.

Note: Since this is a research study and the meaning of individual results is not yet fully validated, no results will be released to owners.
